If you're driving on SD Hwy 18 through Canton, stop and give us a look. We are rich in history and gearing up for the future. The old railroad depot has been moved from its original location and is now housed by the railroad tracks on Hwy 18 in town as the Canton Depot Museum and visitor center.

We are nestled in the valley by the Big Sioux River with some pretty spectacular views. As a stand-alone community, we are the county seat of Lincoln County, the fastest growing county in the state. The clubhouse is also newly remodeled and updated. Check it out.

Our industrial park has seen a lot of action this last year and is nearly full. Plans to expand will be a topic for conversation soon. Three brand new businesses have been building or planning to build this last year.

The Lincoln County courthouse will be expanding soon, moving the Courtrooms and some offices to a new Justice Center on the west edge of the city.

I'm extremely proud of our safety services in Canton. We have a Volunteer Fire Department, and our Canton

Police Department is fully staffed and ready to protect and serve our community, we also have an SRO in our school system for the protection of our children. The police department hosts an Easter Egg Hunt and a bike rodeo, just to name a couple of fun events. Sanford Hospital has a full-time ambulance service at the disposal of Canton and our surrounding community.

Welcome to Lincoln County

Lincoln County, located in southeastern South Dakota, was incorporated December 30, 1867. The Lincoln County Courthouse has marked the center of Canton, the county seat, for many years. The first Courthouse was erected and donated to Lincoln County in 1875 by the Canton Building and Improvement Association.

In 1889 a three and one-half story addition to the east side was built and ready for occupancy by February 1890. In 1899 the original courthouse was removed and the west addition was built and the clock tower was added. In May of 2008 construction was completed on a new Administration Building, which is a three-floor addition to the north side. It houses all of the county administrative offices. The historic building has been renovated to add needed space for Court Services.

A recently completed County Highway Department Building provides room for growth for many years in the future. The upcoming project for a County Justice Center is currently in motion and may provide the county much needed space for the following components such as courts, state's attorney offices, clerk of the courts, public defender, other County Offices, sheriff's office, and a jail.

Lincoln County includes an area of 576 square miles and population of 65,161 at last census. Lincoln County is the fastest growing county in South Dakota.

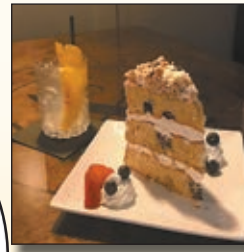
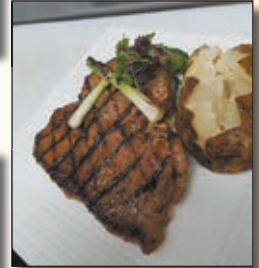

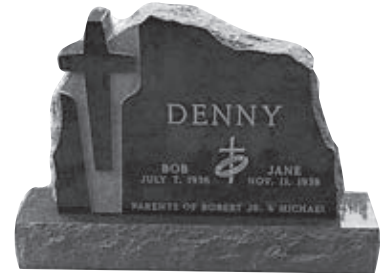

Newton Hills State Park

A quiet, shady campground draws thousands of campers each year to Newton Hills. Campers can stay in the campground, in one of eight camping cabins or the group lodge.

The four-bedroom lodge is a favorite of large groups, particularly of families and groups of hunters or anglers. The lodge features two full baths, a full kitchen, an upper deck and lower walk-out patio. The lodge is furnished. Guests need to bring bedding, bath towels, personal items and food. Contact the park for more information.

After a day on the trail, horseback riders can head for the park's equestrian camp. The trail camp provides facilities for both day and overnight park users, which include vault toilets, water, large parking areas and day and overnight horse corrals.

If you are planning a family get-together, the park has 20' x 20' and 20' x 40' canopy tents available for rent. Please contact the park office for price/details.

Nature Observation

If you're interested in bird-watching, Newton Hills is definitely the place to be. More than 200 species of birds visit the area each year. White-tailed deer, wild turkeys, marmots, rabbits, red and gray fox and squirrels are also found within the park.

Archery deer and turkey hunting are allowed within the park during designated seasons, but uncased bows and firearms are not allowed within the park's campgrounds and picnic areas. Please refer to the hunting handbook for more information. State parks are closed to hunting from May 1 through Sept. 30 of each year

A six-mile multi-use trail leads through dense oak and basswood forest. Woodland Trail is listed in the registry of National Recreation Trails.

Sioux River Folk Festival

Newton Hills hosts a popular musical concert in conjunction with the Friends of Traditional Music. The Sioux River Folk Festival is held annually on the first weekend in August. To learn more about the Sioux River Folk Festival and the Friends of Traditional Music, please visit the website, www.fotm.org.

FestiFALL/CandleLight Walk

Held each year on the first Saturday in October.

The popular FestiFALL event is attended annually by people of all ages, and features many family activities including arts and crafts booths, kid's games and bluegrass music. Visitors are encouraged to bring in their own decorated or carved pumpkins for judging.

The Candlelight Walk leads visitors along 2.2 miles of candle-lit trail through the deep woods of Newton Hills. The trail will be solely lit by candles and carved pumpkins. Throughout the weekend, campers are encouraged to decorate their campsites with a fall theme.

Nature & Recreational Programs

Newton Hills hosts an array of interpretive, educational and recreational activities during the summer season from Open House Weekend through Labor Day. Each program is geared for families with young children and will expose participants to the various natural and cultural features of the park and surrounding area. All of the programs are free to the public; however, a valid park entrance license is required on all vehicles entering the state park.

The amphitheater in the campground is the featured location for most of the programs. At least 3 programs are held every Saturday afternoon. Educational films are presented Friday and Saturday evenings at 9 p.m. The park also has a number of exciting lawn games, horseshoes, game balls, fishing poles, etc., to check out at the welcome center. Senior Center

The current Canton Senior Center is located at 214 E. 4th Street and serves to provide fellowship, social gatherings, daily meals, and recreational and educational programs in a friendly manner for Canton area senior citizens.

Weekly center activities available for seniors are Mah Jong, Bridge and other card games, quilting and knitting activities, puzzles and Birthday Bingo on the first Monday of the month.

Future Canton Community Center

Canton Community Center Committee is getting closer to building a community center of 7,000 to 9,000 square feet located just north of the Canton Depot. With this space we will be able to incorporate a commercial kitchen, dining area, small event area, and multiple rooms for meetings, classes, and groups. The current Senior Nutrition Program, exercise classes, and recreational programs will continue to operate in the new Canton Community Center. Over the past few years, a small group has been hosting a variety of events including; Sunday breakfasts, concessions, Chase the Ace, raffles, and silent auctions to help make a new community center a reality. The group has raised a total of \$587,000, as of January 2024.

The new building can be a safe place for community members to go for socialization and learning. The opportunities are endless for groups or activities that could be hosted in the center. For this to happen in our community, it will require a partnership with



multiple different entities. The project will need to be functional first and then add on other areas as the needs of the community change. There will be room at the back of the lot open for growth opportunities and in the future room for a patio on the southeast side. The location already provides a sizable portion of the parking requirements needed with easy access points for the public. This new facility will provide classroom space, a large dining area for meal programs, a meeting hall, game room, a large kitchen for community events, and approximately 1200 sq. ft. for the Canton VFW and American Legion Posts.

A floor plan has developed, and the city is allowing them to build on the land north of the depot. Now the building process can start, and they may apply for more grants that are available. The total cost of this center is estimated at \$1.6 million. If all things fall into place, they hope to break ground for this facility in summer or fall 2025.

Public Library



The Canton Public Library was built in 1989 in the former location of the historic Bandshell in Jack Fox Park in an effort to create a larger library space for the public. Prior to the library's completion, the facility had been located at the Canton Carnegie Public Library on the southwest corner of 4th Street and Lincoln, where the building still stands today as a private residence.

Today, the library regularly hosts the annual Summer Reading Program for young readers which features reading incentives for young readers, activities, special guests and more. 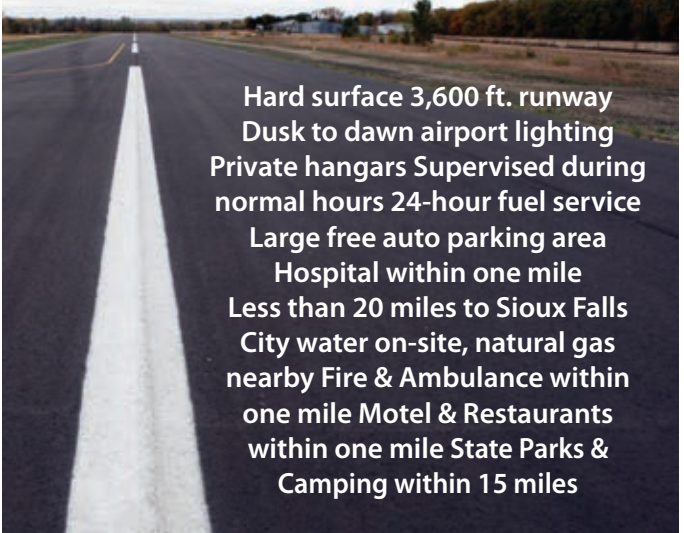
Canton's very own public transportation system, Canton Transit, has been operating over 20 years, providing transportation to children, adults and the elderly.

Canton Economic Development Corporation Building Momentum Through Unified, Team Effort Approach

The Canton Economic Development Corporation has landed its third prospect in the past three years adding an additional business prospect this past fall with the sale of a 4-acre parcel located directly west of Bid-Well, a Terex Brand. The new tenant, named Dakota Specialty Chemical, is a local company with an international presence that will begin their \$4.5 million capital buildout beginning sometime this Spring. The company is seen by community leaders as a good fit for the Canton Industrial Park in multiple respects. They join a group of multiple, long-time current tenants already having significant international footprints. Additionally, Dakota Specialty Chemical joins a list of local businesses/industries with a Agri-science based background.

This momentum began with Decker Sales & Equipment when they made the decision to locate in the Canton Industrial Park approximately two years ago. This business will focus on heavy machinery repair and equipment sales, along with the potential of bringing to market new, innovative residential projects. At the time of the sale of the parcel of land, it was the first parcel of land to sell at the Industrial Park in a approximately a decade. This stagnation encouraged local development leaders to consider a new approach to marketing land out at the industrial park. Their solution was to team an economic development director, along with a listing agent for the industrial park land. This combination has resulted in total capital expenditures of approximately \$7.5



million between three businesses during a very unpredictable economic climate. The three additional businesses are set to add over twenty jobs within the next twelve months and over fifty jobs over the next five years.

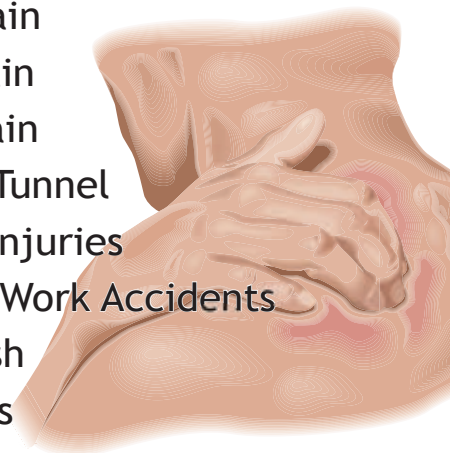
The final addition to the Industrial Park is a buildout of three buildings designed to house contractors' shops. There is availability for up four shops per building. The total capital expenditure of this project will range between \$1 million to approximately \$3 million dollars with each unit capable of adding multiple jobs. This will be based upon the needs of the various tenants of these shops. The builder and owner of these shops is David Wurtz.

These recent expansions, coupled with the job creation, have resulted in the CEDC and City partnering with the South Dakota Governor's Office of Economic Development with plans to complete the road on Innovation Street from west of Adams Building #2 up to the intersection of Innovation Street and 479th Avenue. The CEDC applied for and received, on behalf of the City, a \$423,000.00 Local Infrastructure Improvement Planning Grant allowing for the completion of the road. This will include money that will look to pay for water and sewer utilities in addition to paving of the current gravel surface.

Monarch Village Subdivision Will Bring Much-Needed Housing To Canton Community

The Canton Economic Development Corporation (CEDC) in partnership with EXP Development introduces Monarch Village Subdivision. This is a masterplan subdivision consisting of approximately 64.2 acres of land with approximately 50 acres of the total being developable for housing in the City of Canton. The remaining portion of land will serve to meet the engineering aspects of the project, while also providing future tenants and homeowners with adequate green space as well as a parks system that will be uniquely designed by Charles Yi, a real-estate investor with a portfolio that spans the globe to include experience developing within the State of South Dakota. One of his partners, Mel McGowan, is an eclectic, with a background in film and creative design during a decade long stint at the Walt Disney Company. The hope is this unique background will serve the project well in providing a subdivision with more character and unique value than typically seen in a subdivision within an historically rural community in the Midwest.

The subdivision is being permitted to develop approximately 83 single-family residential lots and up to 200 multi-family and mixed-use residential units. It is currently being planned for a four-phase buildout dependent on market demand. The goal is to provide affordable, workforce housing that is uniquely designed in a suburb setting. This will cause neighboring cities to take notice and it is likely other communities will want to replicate its' unique qualities causing an influx of buyers from other jurisdictions. It will also serve existing residents needs in desiring to upsize or downsize their current homes. There will be unparalleled amenities currently not found in the City of Canton and other surrounding suburbs.

Monarch Village will eventually feature walking trails that traverse the village, water features and a dog park, along with mixed-use commercial/residential as well as retail settings. This will create energy toward outdoor activities and gatherings that seamlessly converge at the "Grandis Pond," an outdoor venue being considered as a place for families to gather.

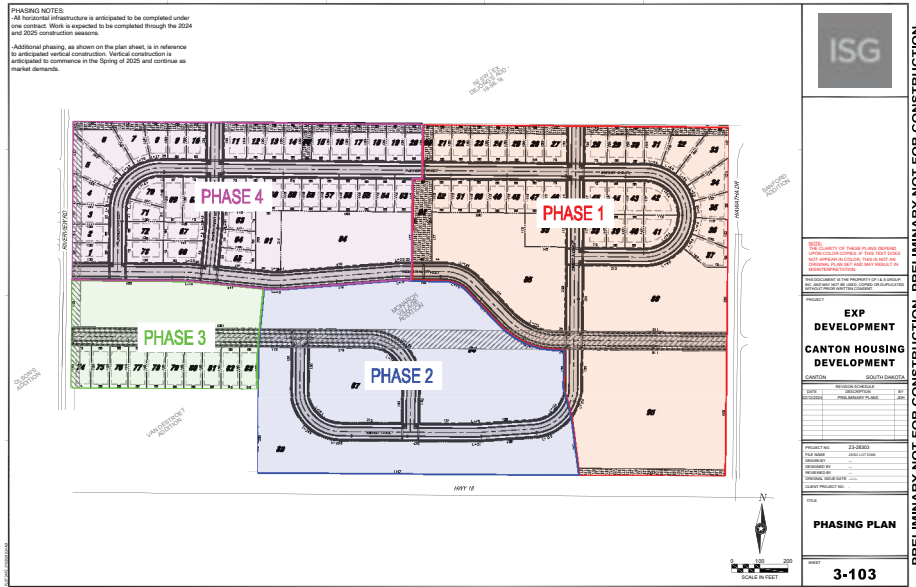

The multi-residential and mixed-use condominiums and townhomes, where "Grandis Pond" is idyllically situated, represent the affordable products of this vibrant village community for Millennials and Gen Z's to rent or purchase.
